



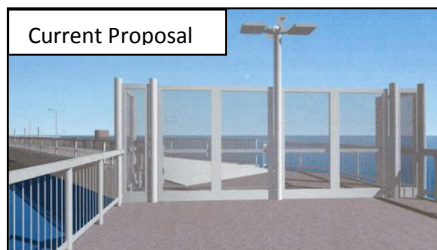
## SAUSALITO FERRY TERMINAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT INFORMATION ABOUT MARCH 2016 REDESIGN

### WHY IS THE SAUSALITO FERRY TERMINAL BEING REPLACED?

- **To keep the ferry facilities structurally sound.** The existing ferry terminal boarding structures are aged and nearing the end of their useful life.
- **To improve ADA accessibility.** The existing ferry terminal gangways and gangplanks are steep and narrow. The District plans to construct the replacement boarding facilities in conformance with the Americans with Disability Act (ADA) guidelines in order to improve overall accessibility.
- **Replacement will improve operational efficiencies.** The existing narrow facilities lead to inefficient boarding and disembarking of passengers. To keep on schedule, ferries must sometimes depart before all waiting passengers can board. The planned improvements will create more streamlined, efficient operations.
- **Replacement will upgrade emergency preparedness.** The new boarding facilities are designed to work with other non-Golden Gate Ferry vessel types in case of emergencies, when ferries may be one of the few transportation options for Sausalito residents.

### YOU TALKED, WE LISTENED.

- Feedback from Sausalito City staff and residents drove significant design changes. The Golden Gate, Highway and Transportation District redesigned the landing in response to input shared at multiple meetings in 2015. The landing design now has a much lower profile and smaller footprint than originally proposed.



- The gate style has changed from roll-up doors to a swing gate with transparent doors.
- Access pier width narrowed from 25 feet to 21 feet.
- Gangway height decreased from 12 feet to 6.7 feet.
- Gangway width narrowed from 21 feet to 16 feet.
